Certified Autism Center

Elmwood Park Zoo is the first Zoo in the nation to be named a Certified Autism Center. The certification, given by the International Board of Credentialing and Continuing Education Standards (IBCCES), is awarded to organizations who have completed, and maintain, a training and review process to better serve individuals with autism and other sensory needs.

AZA Accreditation

Our accreditation by the Association of Zoos and Aquariums (AZA) — of which there are only 240 certified in the United States — ensures our animals receive the highest level of care, our staff abides by the best industry standards, and our educators perform engaging programs that are inclusive to all.
